2026 Great Northeast Boat Show (GNEBS)

These Exhibitor Terms, Rules & Regulations are included in, and part of, the Exhibitor Application /Contract

- 1. Exhibit booths must be staffed at all times throughout the Show by qualified representatives of the Exhibitor. Exhibitors are also expected to keep their space attractive and clean throughout the course of the Show. Dumpsters are available for refuse removal and Exhibitors are responsible for this.
- 2. All charges for exhibit space must be paid in full prior to occupancy by Exhibitor. Booth space not fully paid for by January 15, 2026 or occupied by Exhibitor by 6PM Thursday March 19th, 2026, unless agreed upon in writing by Great Northeast Boat Show Management, (GNEBS) can be sold to another Exhibitor by GNEBS with no refund.
- 3. Liability for loss, theft, property damage or destruction and personal injury:
 - A: Exhibitor hereby waives any and all claims against the Great Northeast Boat Show Management (GNEBS) their agents or representatives resulting from loss, theft, damage or destruction to its property, or from personal injuries to it, it's agents and /or employees.
 - B: Exhibitor assumes full and complete responsibility for any damage that may occur when moving exhibit material in or out of facility, or destruction of property of others, or exhibitors participating in the Show. Exhibitor herby waives any right of indemnification which it may have against GNEBS, their agents or representatives for any and all claims arising from exhibiting at the Show.
- 4. The Exhibitor must provide proof of adequate commercial liability insurance against claims for personal injury, death or property damage occurring upon, in, or about the Show premises with a limit of not less than \$1,000,000 each occurrence. Said insurance shall also provide coverage with respect to Exhibitor's obligations hereunder relative to indemnification. Certificates of insurance must be filed with GNEBS no later than March 1 2026. Without this proof GNEBS management cannot allow an Exhibitor to participate.
- 5. GNEBS reserves the right to determine eligibility of any company, product, signage or material for inclusion in the show. No exhibitor shall exhibit, or permit to be exhibited in the space allocated to them, any product, merchandise, signage or display material other than that specified in this application. Space contracted by the Exhibitor may not be sublet without the prior written permission of GNEBS. The Exhibitor may not distribute literature or promotional material from a third party without the prior written consent of GNEBS. Exhibitor agrees that GNEBS may remove any exhibits that it determines are of a disruptive, objectionable or inappropriate nature.
- 6. The Exhibitor agrees to abide by all terms, regulations and rules adopted by GNEBS in the best interest of the Show, and agrees that GNEBS shall have the final decision in adopting any rule or regulation, or additional rules deemed necessary prior to, during and after the Show.
- 7. The Exhibitor may use the Great Northeast Boat Show logo to promote only his/her participation at the Show.
- 8. GNEBS reserves the right at any time to move, alter or remove exhibits or any part thereof, including printed materials, product, signs, lights or sound, and to expel exhibitors or personnel if, in GNEBS opinion, their conduct or presentation is objectionable to GNEBS, other Exhibitors and/or attendees.
- 9. The Exhibitor agrees to confine his/her presentation to within the contracted space only, and within the maximum height set by the Show rules and regulations (20' high for bulk space) and (8' back wall and 3 foot side walls for 8' x 10' booths) unless otherwise approved by GNEBS in writing.
- 10. All goods shipped to the Show must be prepaid and clearly marked with the name of the Exhibitor and the number of the booth location. GNEBS assumes no responsibility for loss or damage to goods before or during the period of the Show, or after its closing.
- 11. The Exhibitor agrees that no display may be dismantled or goods removed during the entire run of the Show, but must remain intact until after the closing hour of the last day of the Show. The Exhibitor also agrees to remove his/her exhibit, equipment, and appurtenances from the Show venue by the final move out time, or in the event of failure to do so, the Exhibitor agrees to pay for such additional costs as my be incurred.
- 12. GNEBS reserves the right at its sole discretion to change the location and dates upon which the Show is to be held and shall not be liable in damages or otherwise by reason of any such change. In addition, GNEBS shall not be liable in damages or otherwise for failure to carry out the terms of this Agreement in whole or in part where caused directly or indirectly by or in consequence of fire, storm, flood, war, rebellion, insurrection, riot, civil commotion, strike or by any cause whatsoever beyond the control of GNEBS.
- 13. GNEBS reserves the right to cancel this contract and to withhold possession of exhibit space if the Exhibitor fails to perform any material condition of this contract or refuses to abide by the Show rules and regulations, in which case the Exhibitor shall forfeit as liquidation damages all space rental payments made by him/her and any further occupancy of such space. No refunds.
- 14. The Exhibitor agrees to observe and abide by all arrangements and agreements between GNEBS and venue management.
- 15. GNEBS reserves the right to alter or change the space assigned to the Exhibitor. No part of any exhibit or any signs relating therefrom, shall be pasted, nailed or otherwise attached to the walls, doors, etc. without the written approval of GNEBS and in any way as to deface same, damage arising by failure to observe these rules shall be paid by the exhibitor. Exhibitors must use measures to protect the venue buildings, exhibit booth partitions, tables, chairs, wall columns, ceilings and floors from all damages. The Exhibitor will be held responsible for any charges by the venue for any damage to their equipment, building, ground, or for clean-up caused by paint, grease, gas, oil, or excess debris left in the exhibitor's space.
- 16.Exhibitor sampling or selling of food or beverages is prohibited during the Show without prior written approval from GNEBS.
- 17. Force Majeure. GNEBS Show management shall not be liable for any failure to perform its obligations under the Agreement, these rules or any Additional Rules or for any liability, cost or expense arising out of or in connection with its decision to cancel the show due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control including, without limitation, hurricanes, tornados, fires or other natural disasters, terrorism, riots, sabotage, strikes, labor disputes, war, any act or omission of any government or governmental authority, declarations or orders of government, power failure, computer failure, telecommunications failure, curtailment of transportation facilities, infectious disease, epidemic, or other similar cause or other events beyond its control, including emergency or non- emergency conditions (each a "force majeure event). In the event show management cancels, postpones, or delays the show or otherwise fails to perform its obligations under the Agreement due to a force majeure event, show management will not be liable or responsible for any damages, losses, fines, fees, penalties, or other expenses incurred by exhibitor in connection with such failure. Notwithstanding the foregoing, in the event the show is cancelled due to a force majeure event or a force majeure event prevents exhibitor's show space from being made available to exhibitor at the start of the show, the Agreement shall terminate and exhibitor hereby waives any claim for property or other damages or compensation except for a pro-rata refund on the amount paid by exhibitor under the Agreement after deduction of expenses and losses incurred by show management in connection with said show and there shall be no further liability on the part of either party.
